

Get creative... start planning your event!

- Organise an interfaith walk or doors open day visiting different places of worship in your area
- Hold an interfaith architecture tour in your city
- Run a faith and fashion show
- Host an interfaith dialogue evening around the creativity and the arts theme
- Enjoy a multi faith meal or run a pop up interfaith café across the week for the community
- Put on a music event with contributions from different communities and cultures
- Approach members of other local faith communities to put on a joint event during interfaith week
- Engage with local schools to organise a special assembly, arts competition, exhibition, or concert
- Plan a conference with a local university or college
- Set up a faith fair where faith societies provide educational displays and arts workshops
- Organise an interfaith open mic event to enjoy music and poetry from people in your local area from different backgrounds
- Encourage your teachers or lecturers to create a class around the theme (this could be from the arts faculty, philosophy, history or theology departments)
- Arrange a seminar around the theme of interfaith week
- Make a video or create a social media campaign
- Why not hold an interfaith bake off, baking breads and cakes from different faiths and cultures
- Arrange an activity to learn about the calligraphy or art of particular faith traditions
- Write or produce a play with an interfaith theme
- Run a photography or art competition with a religion and belief theme
- Encourage artists from a range of backgrounds to collaborate on a particular work or series of works
- Hold an interfaith comedy night
- Arrange an exhibition of religious art/iconography
- Include a dish at your work canteen linked to a different faith each day of the week
- Approach your local paper or a journalist to run a special feature on interfaith week
- Cover events that are happening in your local area and blog about them, and send them to us
- Interview people of faith in your community
