

Scottish Interfaith Week 2019 'Eat Share Love' Art Competition



To celebrate **Scottish Interfaith Week 2019**, Interfaith Scotland is looking for budding artists to take part in our **'Eat Share Love'** competition. There is a top prize of £50, second prize of £20 and third prize of £10. Winning entries will have their work displayed at the launch of Scottish Interfaith Week taking place in Perth on 10th November 2019. You will be invited to attend this event and receive your prizes. Entries are open to individuals and groups of all ages. If a group wins, the prize money is to be shared between the group members. You do not need to be part of a faith group to enter this competition.

What is 'Interfaith'?

Interfaith is when people from different religions and beliefs come together to talk and better understand people from different faiths and backgrounds. It can happen in lots of different ways such as making friends, going along to festival celebrations, visiting different places of worship or volunteering together to help people and the environment. What is 'Scottish Interfaith Week'?

Scottish Interfaith Week is taking place from **10th – 17th November 2019**. The week gives people an opportunity to plan and attend events that bring local people from different faiths and beliefs together all over Scotland. Each year we have a different theme to the week and this year is 'Eat Share Love'.

The theme of 'Eat Share Love' and ways to get involved in the week

Sharing food is a great way of bringing people together and sharing with one another and making new friends. This year the theme is 'Eat Share Love' and we are encouraging people to learn about each other's faith or culture by sharing food, stories and recipes. Enjoy a meal together; share recipes and skills; cook together or for each other. Eat, sing, dance, talk, create, innovate, experience and most importantly, enjoy! Getting involved is easy; you can organise anything from a small gathering in your home or community centre to a large event in your local place of worship, school or library. We encourage everyone to participate and the SIFW team are always happy to help you with ideas and promoting your event!

What is the competition about?

We want to encourage people to submit different items on the theme of 'Eat Share Love'. These could include:

- A drawing or painting
- A photo montage
- A poem
- A video or animation
- A piece of writing
- A song
- A piece of music
- A piece of drama
